

BRITANNICA SATURDAY SCHOOL POLICIES

Discount policy:	<p>Discounts on activity fees are offered for participants who enroll for more than one session per week in Britannica Saturday Morning School as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 session per week – full price - 2 sessions per week – 10% discount on activity fees - 3 sessions per week – 15% discount on activity fees <p>Sibling discounts of 10% for all Primary and EYFS students</p>
Registration policy:	<p>Registrations are accepted only by filling out and signing the registration form. Spots are filled first-come-first-serve basis. Payments must be made in cash at Britannica International School. Registrations in the middle of the course are accepted subject to availability and teacher’s discretion. Should participant join an activity in the middle of the course, they must pay a pro-rated fee that covers the entirety of the remaining classes of the course.</p>
Refund policy:	<p>In case of cancelling the registration 7 days before the course start, 100% of course fees are refunded. In case of cancelling the registration 1-6 days before the course start, 80% of course fees are refunded. In case of cancelling the registration in the middle of the course, class fee are refunded on pro-rata basis, deducting a registration fee RMB 100.</p>
Weather policy:	<p>Classes will take place regardless of the weather. In case of rain or poor air quality, the outdoor activities are moved indoors and in that case Britannica reserves the right to make adjustments to activities as needed. In case of extreme weather conditions that cause safety issue or hazardous air quality, classes are cancelled. In such cases, participants are informed by SMS and emails 1,5 hours before the classes start. Britannica will take best efforts to provide make-up classes but it is not guaranteed. Britannica will not offer refunds for cancellations in such situations which are considered force majeure.</p>
Liability waiver:	<p>As a parent or guardian, I understand and agree that Britannica International School, its employees, officers, directors, volunteers and parties providing services to the school will not be liable to the claims, demands, any personal injury, damages or theft to or of my child’s property or otherwise, whatsoever or howsoever arising, weather through negligence or otherwise, resulting from, or occurring in connection with, activities organised by Britannica International School.</p>
Photo Release:	<p>I allow my child’s photos to be edited, copied, published and distributed in Britannica International School’s marketing including (but not limiting to) school’s website, local press and media an in school’s social media channels. I waive right to inspect or approve the finish product, including written or electronic copy, wherein the participant appears.</p>
Medical Authorisation:	<p>As a parent or guardian, I hereby authorize the teachers and staff of Britannica International School to seek medical treatment for my child in case of injury that requires medical attention. If further attention beyond the capabilities of our teachers and staff is required, I understand that Britannica International School will use the medical facility and means of transportation of its discretion.</p>
